Purpose:

To provide a consistent approach to boulevard maintenance.

Statement:

The Town of Hanna requires property owners to develop and maintain boulevards adjacent to the property. This includes but is not limited to grass maintenance and tree trimming. In all developments it should be noted that the boulevard may be used for placing snow removed from the street.

Policy:

At the discretion of the Director of Public Works, the Town will remove existing grass and dirt from boulevards to allow for improvements proposed by the property owner. The Town will provide grass seed for restoration and uniformity. Other materials may be used, however, approval must be granted by Town Administration.

Trees may be placed on the boulevard at the property owner's expense, on the condition that they do not obstruct the street or the sidewalk, create a site line problem for vehicular traffic or restrict access for underground utilities.

Property owners wanting to remove trees from the boulevard may do so at their own expense.

The Town may, at it's discretion, trim or remove any boulevard tree for safety reasons.
